**amo** – regular 1st conj verb – *I love*  
**audio** – regular 4th conj verb – *I hear*  
**capio, capere, cepi, captum** – 3.5 conj verb – *I take*  
**celeriter** – adverb – *quickly*  
**cognosco, cognoscere, cognovi, cognitum** – 3 conj verb – *I understand,*

**descend, descendere, descendi, descensum** – 3rd conj verb *I descend, climb down;*  
**discedo, discedere, discessi, discessum** – 3rd conj verb – *go/march off, depart*  
**duo** – *two* nom **duo/duae/duo** acc **duo** or **duos/duas/duo**  
**eius** – *of him/her/it* or *his/her/its* see **is/ea/id** and Briefing 2  
**sum, esse, Fut: ero, Imperf: eram, fui** – irregular *I am*  
**et** – conjunction – *and*  
**etiam** conjunction – *also, and also*  
**expello, expellere, expuli, expulsus** – 3rd conj – *I drive out, expel*  
**facio, facere, feci, factum** – 3.5 conj verb – *I make or do*  
**femina** – 1st decl noun fem – *girl, woman*  
**festino** – regular 1st conj verb – *I hurry*  
**filia** – 1st decl noun fem – *daughter*  
**filius** – 2nd decl noun masc – *son*  
**frater, fratris** – 3rd decl noun masc – *brother*  
**fugio, fugere, fugi, fugitum** – 3.5 conj verb – *I flee, fly, run away;*  
**geminus** – 2nd decl noun masc – *twin*  
**habeo** – regular 2nd conj verb – *I have*  
**habito** – regular 1st conj verb – *I live/dwell in*  
**haec** – these things – see **hic**  
**hic** – pronoun *this* – see **Briefing 2**  
**iacio, iacere, ieci, iactum** – 3rd conj verb – *throw, hurl,*  
**ibi** – adverb – *there*  
**ille** – pronoun *that* – see **Briefing 2**  
**in**– preposition *into/onto* with accusative, *in/on* with ablative  
**infans, infantis** – 3rd decl noun – *child, infant*  
**inquit** – *he said*  
**invenio, invenire, inveni, inventum** – 4th conj verb *discover, find;*  
**irate** – adverb – *angrily*  
**iratus** – 1st/2nd decl adjective – *angry*  
**ita, itaque** – adverb – *so*  
**iubeo, iubere, iussi, iussum** – 2nd conj verb – *I order/tell/command/direct*  
**lac, lactis** – 3rd decl noun – neut – *milk*  
**laetus** – 1st/2nd decl adjective – *happy*  
**liberare** – regular 1st conj verb – *I free*  
**locus** – 2nd decl noun masc – *place*  
**lupa** – 1st decl noun fem – *she-wolf*  
**maior** – comparative of **magnus** – *more, bigger*  
**miles, militis** – 3rd decl noun – masc – *soldier*  
**mille** – number – *a thousand*  
**mors, mortis** – 3rd decl noun – fem – *death*  
**mox** – adverb – *soon*  
**multus** – 1st/2nd decl adjective – *many*

**natu** – ablative of supine **natus** from **nascor** (*I am born*) – *by birth*  
**navis, navis** – 3rd decl noun fem – *ship*  
**navigavo** – regular 1st conj verb – *I sail, travel*  
**neco** – regular 1st conj verb – *I kill*  
**nomen, nominis** – 3rd decl noun neut – *name*  
**non** – adverb – *not*  
**numquam** – adverb – *never*  
**nunc** – adverb – *now*  
**nuntius** – 2nd decl noun masc – *news*  
**olim** – adverb – *once upon a time*  
**pastor, pastoris** – 3rd decl noun – *shepherd, herdsman*;  
**pater, patris** – 3rd decl noun – *father*  
**pario, parere, peperit, partum** – 3rd conj verb – *give birth to*  
**post** – preposition taking accusative – *behind*  
**prope** – preposition taking accusative – *near*  
**propter** – preposition taking accusative – *on account of*  
**puella** – 1st decl noun fem – *girl*  
**puer** – 2nd decl noun masc – *boy*  
**pulcher** – 1st/2nd decl adjective – *beautiful, handsome* (Comparative **pulchrior**, Superlative **pulcherrimus**)  
**punio** – regular 4th conj verb – *I punish*  
**quae** – nom sing fem or nom/acc plur neut – see **quis/quae/quid** (*which?*) or **qui/quae/quod** (*who/that*)  
**quamquam** – conj – *although*  
**-que** – conjunction – *and*  
**qui/quae/quod** – relative pronoun – *which* – see Briefing 2  
**quis/quae/quid?** – interrogative pronoun – *Which? What?* see Briefing 2  
**quoque** – adverb – *also*  
**relinquo, relinquere, reliqui, relictum** – 3rd conj verb *leave behind, abandon*  
**rex, regis** – 3rd decl noun – *king*  
**ripa** – 1st decl noun fem – *bank*  
**rogo** – regular 1st conj verb – *I ask, beg*  
**servo** – regular 1st conj verb – *I save serve*  
**servus** – 2nd decl noun – masc – *slave*  
**sic** – adverb – *thus*  
**statim** – adverb – *at once*  
**suus** – personal pronominal adjective (gen sing **suius**, dat sing **sui**) – *his own, her own, its own, their own*  
**tamen** – adverb – *therefore*  
**tandem** – adverb – *at length*  
**tum** – conjunction or adverb – *then, moreover*  
**ubi** – conjunction – *when / where* – often with subjunctive mood  
**unus** – pronominal adjective – *one* (gen sing **unius**, dat sing **uni**)  
**uxor, uxoris** – 3rd decl noun fem – *wife*  
**venio, venire, veni, ventum** 4th conj irreg – *I come*  
**verbum** – 2nd decl noun neut – *word*  
**video, videre, vidi, visum** – 2nd conj verb – *I see*  
**voco** – regular 1st conj verb – *I love*  
**volo, velle, volui** – irreg verb – *I want* – see Briefing 3.
